**Summary:**

The victim, a free lance pilot was last seen on 04-06-1980 at a bar inside the Holiday Inn Hotel at I-29 and 291 Highway. The victim responded to the bar to meet a man who wanted to hire him for a job flying parts to oil fields in Oklahoma City. The victim arrived at the bar at approximately 1930 hours and met with an individual who identified himself as Pete Peterson. The victim left the bar with subject Peterson and never returned. Subject Peterson returned to the bar at approximately 2100 hours dressed in different clothing. The victim's body was discovered on 05-04-1980 at 1724 hours in a partially wooded area at 108<sup>th</sup> and Skyview. The cause of death was multiple gunshot wounds. The victim was involved in a highly contested divorce involving custody of his children. The victim's wife and mother in-law made threats to harm the victim. The victim's vehicle was discovered abandoned in long term parking lot "E" at KCI Airport on 04-08-1980 at 1015 hours. A heavy concentration of blood was found in the passenger side, floor area of the vehicle.
