## KCMO Snow Programs:

### Arterial Program

- \* Large dump trucks
- \* Plow curb to curb
- \* 10 foot (min) plow width
- \* Plow and salt
- \* Daytime/nighttime shifts
- \* 36 plow routes

### Residential Program

- \* Pick up trucks
- \* One pass only
- \* 7 1/2 foot plow width
- \* Primary focus: plowing
- \* Salt hills, curves, intersections
- \* Daytime shifts only
- \* 67 plow routes

## What is a “snow event”?

Every predicted snowstorm is considered an event. When a winter weather event is predicted, we take several steps:

- ⇒ **Determine type of precipitation**
- ⇒ **Determine start of event**
- ⇒ **Send crews into split shifts (AM/PM)**
- ⇒ **Pre-treat with brine before snow event**
- ⇒ **Run snow operations during storm**
- ⇒ **Take slick calls after storm ends**

Every snow event is different. Our experts decide on an operational snow plan based on the weather conditions of each storm.
