Municipal Court extends COVID-19 emergency measures following extension of the Mayor's Stay at Home Order to May 15

In a continuing effort to prevent the spread of COVID-19, Municipal Court will not allow public entry to the building past security through May 15.

- The doors remain open and a drop box just before security is available for payments using a check or money order. However, payments are encouraged to be made online at www.kcmo.gov/court or by mail at P.O Box 219381, Kansas City, MO 64121-9381.
- Bonds can be posted at any KCPD patrol station.
- All hearings and trials for defendants not already in custody are postponed. In-custody hearings are being held via video from the detention facilities.
- New court dates for continued cases will be mailed to defendants at the address on file. If you have a pending case, you must keep your address updated with the court. To update your address, email court@kcmo.org or call 816-513-2700.
- All walk-in dockets are cancelled.
- Probationers can contact their probation officers directly or by email at probation@kcmo.org or call 816-513-2700 for alternatives to in-person reporting.
- Victims and City witnesses should contact the City Prosecutor's Office for information by email at witness@kcmo.org or by phone at 816-513-6750.
- To maintain social distancing, court personnel are working on rotation and remotely with limited resources to process email filings and information requests. Expect longer response times.
