WHEREAS this Court per Missouri Supreme Court Order dated May 4, 2020, will continue to suspend non-essential in person hearings until a future date to be determined after operational directives have been met for a sustained period of time, and

WHEREAS the Court in consultation with local health officials results in a determination that the local status of the COVID-19 pandemic is such that it is appropriate to "phase up" and consider limited in person appearances and hearings, and

WHEREAS the Court remains open to all non-essential hearings as defined by Missouri Supreme Court Order by way of telephone or video hearings and appearances, and



IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT the Court Docket Matrix of the Kansas City Municipal Court as last amended on October 17, 2019 is hereby suspended until further notice due to the COVID-19 pandemic. A temporary docket schedule will take the place of the Court Docket Matrix to allow for virtual appearances and limited in person hearings consistent with the Missouri Supreme Court Order dated April 17, 2020 to be superseded by Missouri Supreme Court Order dated May 4, 2020 effective May 16, 2020. Per the Missouri Supreme Court Order date May 4, 2020, Kansas City Municipal Court is in "Phase Zero" of the Supreme Court's operational directives. This order suspending the court docket matrix shall remain in effect until terminated by a subsequent order of the Presiding Judge of Kansas City Municipal Court.

WHEREAS this Court per Missouri Supreme Court Order dated April 17, 2020 continues to suspend non-essential in person hearings, and


WHEREAS this Court per Missouri Supreme Court Order dated May 4, 2020, will continue to suspend non-essential in person hearings until a future date to be determined after operational directives have been met for a sustained period of time, and

WHEREAS the Court in consultation with local health officials results in a determination that the local status of the COVID-19 pandemic is such that it is appropriate to “phase up” and consider limited in person appearances and hearings, and

WHEREAS the Court remains open to all non-essential hearings as defined by Missouri Supreme Court Order by way of telephone or video hearings and appearances.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT two temporary special committees are created by this order to address the day to day changes in orders and guidelines related to the operations of the judicial system under COVID-19 and to further access the best practices specific to this court in preparation of phasing up in the reopening process at the appropriate time. The two committees designated to address the reopening process are: Phasing up Specialty Court Committee and Phasing up Traffic Court Committee. The Presiding Judge will appoint himself and two other Judges to each committee. Other members on the committee may include but not limited to specialty court coordinators, court administration, the city prosecutor, legal aid, and representatives of the City Health Department.
