

Municipal Court Slow Opening Delayed

Due to recent trends in COVID-19 cases and after conferring with the Health Department and pursuant to new Missouri Supreme Court orders issued July 24, 2020, the Kansas City, Missouri Municipal Court has delayed its slow opening plans.

No members of the public allowed past security until further notice.

All entering must wear a mask covering mouth and nose and may be subject to temperature screening.

If you have scheduled hearings or receive notice of any court date through August 31 (including Attorney Status hearings) it is for a virtual, online hearing. **DO NOT COME to Municipal Court in person.**

To attend/participate in your hearing:

1. **GO TO** www.kcmo.gov/court
2. Click on [Virtual Hearing Links Calendar](#)
 - You can view the calendar by month, week or day
3. Find and click the link on the calendar for the date, time and courtroom on your notice
4. **If you do not attend your virtual hearing**, you will be required to attend in person at a later date and a mailing will be sent to your last known address. Please keep your address updated with the court.

All other cases scheduled will be continued for in-person court dates later in the year. All walk-in dockets are cancelled.

- **Notices are mailed to the defendant's address on file. Keep addresses updated with the court.**
- Apply for a virtual hearing if you want to address your case earlier by going to www.kcmo.gov/court

YOU ARE ENCOURAGED TO PARTICIPATE IN YOUR SCHEDULED VIRTUAL HEARING. Wait times will be longer than normal for in-person hearings later this year and dockets will be limited.
