



CODES VIOLATIONS

How many code violations?

- **17,881 code violations of which 4827 are on owner occupied properties.**

How many resolved codes?

- **4518 code violations were closed of which 1153 are on owner occupied properties.**
- **As of the end of the fourth quarter the total violations in the 3rd District was 13,363.**

How many codes cases?

- **5560 Code Cases** of which **1482** are owner occupied (**27%**)

How many resolved codes cases?

- **1012 Code Cases** closed of which **223** are owner occupied (**22%**)
- **Owner occupied properties** have a median close date of **25 days** vs **42 days** for others.

Street Maintenance: What street maintenance was completed to date in 3rd Council District?

- Potholes patched: **345** (reflects pothole cases reported to 311 from February 2020 – April 2020)
 - Cases Open: **10**
 - Crews have **patched 97% of potholes reported to 311 in council district 3 from Feb-Apr 2020**
- Signs replaced: **385** signs were replaced in council district 3 to date
- Lanes painted: **100% of long lines** in council district 3 are painted to date
- Crosswalks painted: **657** (includes regular and continental style)
- Roads resurfaced/microsurfaced: **1** (see back page for locations)
- Money allocated for FY 19-20: **~\$1.5M*** (pothole patching, crack sealing, ditching, alleyway maintenance)
 - Does not include snow removal or mowing— these are separate, citywide budget allocations

- Sidewalks: **\$3,058,337.84*** or **34% of total GO Bond Sidewalk budget**
 - Citywide: \$9,105,665.39*

 - Citywide: \$76,724,016*
 - *Since year 1 of GO Bond Program
