History

- PIAC request submitted 2019
- \$500,000 approved for fiscal year 2020
- Additional grant funding submitted summer of 2020 (not awarded)
- Engineering Firm of HDR selected summer of 2020
- Public meeting #1: December 17, 2020
- Public meeting #2: April 6, 2021
